COMPETITION RULES & REGULATIONS

1. All exhibits for the competition must be grown by or produced under the direction/supervision of the exhibitor.
2. All exhibits should be placed with the printed label/tag properly filled-up by the competitors. The label/tag will be supplied at the time of registration of the exhibit for the competition and must bear the following information:
 - (i) Tag serial number (ii) Class of competition (iii) Section of competition (iv) Name & type of exhibit
3. All exhibits should be in natural bloom. No polishing should be done while cleaning. Fruits and vegetables meant for competition must be with the parental stalk/branch.
4. All containers holding plant exhibits should look clean and coloured in brick red. The pot or container or vase used for exhibits must not be marked or numbered with anything to indicate the identity of the exhibitor.
5. Plants raised on ground and filled in pots on the eve of the competition will be disqualified for competing as pot plants.

6. For cut flowers, the competitors should bring their own vase/container of standard size. No plastic water bottles of ordinary look will be entertained.
7. The Exhibition & Competition Sub Committee will take every care against loss or damage of exhibits and containers. However, the responsibility of taking back the containers will be with the competitors.
8. Competitors should note that the items registered for competition will only be returned to them in the evening of the last day of the Agri-Horti show upon production of the counterfoil of the registration tag.
9. In the event of there being less than 5 entries in any section, the judges may or may not award the scheduled prizes and may consider for consolation prize.
10. No competitor or unauthorized person should enter the competition premises while judging is in progress or make contact with any judge before or till the judging process is over.
11. The decision of the judges on the award of prizes will be final and binding and no appeals or pleas shall be entertained.
